Federal Forms

Federal law provides funding for local public school systems based on the number of students whose parents/guardians work on federally owned property in the State of Maryland. These funds are provided by Congress to compensate the public for the land areas removed from the tax rolls for government use, increased student attendance in the public schools because of the government installations, or a combination of the two. The parent/guardian can be employed by the federal government working in the State of Maryland or be a contractor working on a project on federally owned property located in the State of Maryland.
