<p><b>Literacy:</b> The percentage of all students in grade K-2 meeting the HCPSS Fountas and Pinnell benchmark end of year target will increase from 67.7% to 73%, with the gap between English Language Learners (ELL) and students overall decreasing.</p> <p><b>Mathematics:</b> The percentage of all students in grades 1-5 meeting the HCPSS Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) mathematics benchmark end of year target will increase from 34.5% to 40%, with the gap between ELL's and students overall decreasing.</p>
