

Apply for SNAP Benefits Today!



In response to the global pandemic the Maryland Department of Human Services will provide all current Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients and new eligible applicants with the **maximum benefit** amount for April and May. **Income guidelines for eligibility still apply.**

- **Apply by phone:** Local Department of Social Services cannot take applications by phone. If you want to apply by phone or need assistance with applying, contact **Maryland Hunger Solutions (MHS)** at 866-821-5552 for assistance with a **new** SNAP application only. MHS does not have access to existing SNAP applications. Call M-F between 10AM- 6PM and leave your name and a phone number. MHS is experiencing a very high call volume.

- If you are approved, you will receive benefits for the entire month.
