STRATEGIES

English Language Arts

Staff will increase their knowledge of grade level foundational skill standards, integration of word study, and differentiated writing into ELA instruction.

- Collaborative planning focused on foundational skills and word study instruction
- Professional learning on word study and foundational skills and using student writing to identify gaps in foundational skills
- Collaborative planning in writing utilizing common grade level rubrics.

Mathematics

Staff will implement high quality Number Talks consistently during opening number routines and connect varied representations of mathematical concepts and strategies during instruction.

- Instructional staff will engage in Number Talks professional learning supported by the mathematics office through asynchronous modules, after school training sessions, and/or site-based sessions.
- Instructional staff will effectively plan for and implement number talks during mathematics instruction.
- Instructional staff will engage in professional learning to better understand how to connect representations to one another and connect representations to specific concepts and/or problem types.

School Climate

Staff will continue to develop a positive school culture and climate for students and families.

- All staff will create a restorative culture where students and families feel welcomed and included, community-building is prioritized, and positive conversations are frequent during the day.
- Staff will engage in professional learning on the use of restorative practices.
